Follow-up on Flooding Delta

The cities which were damaged are slowly being cleared of rotting wood, buildings, and debris that had been carried into the cities by the flooding river deltas. Some of the smaller towns which were cleared faster that the cities have a few buildings already set up. Pear County's capital still has some standing water in the city, but the progress of the rebuilding is going smoothly despite it.

The many of the refugees have returned to their damages cities and are camping in tents and huts along the outskirts. Food, clothes, and necessities have been bountifully contributed to these homeless Animals by several private charitable organizations, many churches and a few rich individuals.

Thankfully, the Four Winds Harbor has finally been cleared of corpses. The stench of decay from the ocean should clear soon, but the disease that has spread among the coastal cities is terrible. Many are sick and one Animal has died because of the contamination.

Burying the dead has been a chore. One cemetery has been filled already with dead Animals. Several counties have volunteered to bury the dead in their cemeteries. The final total of the deaths is 2,305. Only 1,500 of the dead have been buried, and Animals are doing their best to dig the graves quickly.

Exclusive Interviews with Iceberg Rose and Fritz Fir

Two Animals who have been on this continent ever since it was discovered and helped colonize Animalzania are Iceburg Rose and Fritz Fir. Each are cousins related to eachother on their mother's and father's sides. They both fought in the war to liberate France from the Communists and were both captured during that war. Iceburg Rose ran for President in 2011, but left the race due his wanting to fight for his country. Fritz has been married to Serena Rose and they have two children. He is a farmer in Farjay. Iceberg is a space explorer for the A.S.S.E.

Question one: Why did you decide to fight in the war to liberate France?

Iceburg: I decided to join the war because I believed that the French ought to be free from the tyranny of others: especially the Communists. If we did not try to defend their rights and stand up against Communism, we would have been dishonored as a nation who vows to stand up for the rights of Animals. We declared war on France in an act of self-defense and because the French people who were under the tyranny of the Communist regieme begged for us to help them. Question two: What did you think when you were captured by the French: were you in dispair or were you hopeful?

Iceburg: I was in dispair when I got captured by the French. I had no clue how long it would take them to figure out that I was the son of President John Rose of Pearl County. Because of this, I was afraid daily of exicution. Also, I was worried about my sister and my cousins who I learned were in the same predicament. Later, I became hopeful when I realized that they did not know who we were. True, the tortures were cruel, and life was tough; but the knowledge that God was with me helped sustain me through that tough time. I knew we would be rescued, either by death or by the French resistence and Animalzanian troops. I am grateful to God that Serena, Fritz, Thomas, Luke, and I were able to escape the Communists alive.

Fritz: I was hopeful. I was hopeful because I knew that no matter what, we would win. I knew that no matter what we would make sure that we would liberate all who were captive and helpless. Praise be to God for his mercy by not letting us lose hope during that dark time.

Question three: What would you consider was the most difficult moment during the French War?

Iceburg: The most dificult moment was when I was captured and tortured. It was then that all I had to cling to was God, and it was tough to stay focused. My sister and brother were with me, and I was constantly afraid to hear their ID numbers among the list of killed or, as they liked to put it, "mercifully slain" list. I am thankful that God protected us and helped us during that difficult time.

Fritz: What to do with the government leaders of the French. I must confess, at times, I felt hatred for them, but in the end I forgave them.

Question four: What is your greatest ambition or dream?

Iceburg: My greatest ambition would be to live in space. Since I was young, my dream was to be an animalnaut and explore the galaxies. My sister Serena and I would pretend to be space explorers when we were young and would wile the hours away with adventures and fights in space. Now that I am grown up, it seems that God has granted me my dream. I have been able to sail in the heavens and explore the wonders of space.

Fritz: This is my dream and ambition: help those that can't help themselves, and give freedom to the captive.

Question five: What do you do now?

Iceburg: I currently am working for the A.S.S.E. In exploration. It is a fun job with lots of risks and reponsibilities. I also have an automoble business.

Firtz: My present job now is being a offduty soldier. I have enjoyed my time fighting for other Animal's freedom. I intend to stay that way.


The people have been mourning over the deaths. Many families lost the only income provider they had. For now, M.F.O. is helping clean up debris, and comfort people.

You had asked what my room looks like. I was going to sent you a photo of it, but as it is very messy, this time of the year. I will tell you how it looks.


